1. INTRODUCTION:

The National Institute of Technical Teachers Training and Research (NITTTR) Chennai was established as an autonomous Institute by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India in the year 1964 to improve the quality of Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) system in India and in the Southern Region in particular. Within this mandate, the institute takes initiatives to offer need based Human Resource Development programmes through appropriate modes and develop curricula and instructional resources. It also fosters research in the inter disciplinary area of Engineering Education and offers consultancy and extension services for the total development of Engineering Colleges, Polytechnic Colleges, Vocational institutions, Industry, Service sector and the Community at large.

The Institute plans to offer the **Master of Technology (Human Resource Development) [M.Tech. (HRD)]** as a long-term programme in 2015 – 2017. M.Tech. (HRD) degree programme will be affiliated to the University of Madras. Eight batches have been completed.

2. FACILITIES:

Besides the Engineering Laboratories, the Institute has a well-equipped Library with 1800 peer-reviewed e-journals access, wide range of computer facilities, NMEICT-NPTEL Phase 1 & 2 video lectures, Educational Technology Laboratory, Centre for Environmental Management, Multi-media Centre, CADD Suite, GIS Centre, CCTV Studio for Micro-teaching and an ETV Production Centre.

3. PROGRAMME GOALS:

- Develop appropriate model(s) for planning and development of programmes which are relevant for HRD in order to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of HR in the context of globalization.
- Analyse the issues, models and methodologies for designing, implementing and evaluating the curriculum of HRD programmes vis-à-vis the needs of the system.
- Generate dependable and workable solutions to problems in such areas as needs analysis, programme planning, courseware development, and organizing human resource development programmes to meet the demands of various sectors of government, industries and services.
- ➤ Evolve procedures for review, evaluation, and development of policies in HRD in Government / Organized Sectors / technical education sector in order to bring about qualitative improvements in HRD.
- ➤ Develop models for HRD in Indian Industries / Institutions and develop specialists to undertake various functions in HRD in these industries / institutions.

4. PROGRAMME UTILITY:

This four semester programme is unique in India. It aims to develop professionals to organize HRD programmes in Technical Institutes like Polytechnics, Engineering Colleges, IITs, NITs, Technical Universities, Manufacturing and Service Sector, IT Sector, Public Sector undertakings, and Recruitment and Consultancy Agencies.

The programme has been prepared to provide adequate skills in HRM and HRD like recruitment, selection, orientation, performance appraisal, planning, development and implementation of training programmes, preparation of training packages using print and electronic media. There will be adequate exposure to corporate training centres.

5. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

Candidates holding a Degree in Engineering / Technology of any University recognized by the Syndicate of University of Madras as equivalent thereto.

6. SPONSORSHIP:

Engineering College and Polytechnic teachers with B.E. / B.Tech. qualifications working in the Southern Region are eligible to be sponsored by their respective Directorate of Technical Education.

7. SCREENING OF APPLICATIONS:

All applicants need not be called for the written test. The screening committee may fix additional/stiffer criteria and may restrict the candidates to be called for the written test.

8. SELECTION PROCESS:

The following are the criteria for selection:

i. Marks obtained in the B.E./B.Tech. (II year to Final year) - 60%
 ii. Aptitude Test - 40%

The written test comprises of 100 objective test items and one or two structured questions to assess the aptitude, entry behaviour, career goal, likely contribution, etc.

The rank order will be prepared based on merit.

The statutory provisions (as per Govt. of India regulation) for reservation of seats will be available to the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC and Persons With Disabilities.

9. PROGRAMME STRUCTURE:

The course will be spread over four semesters, each of 18 weeks duration. There will be an industrial internship during summer, in the first year. The courses of study are as follows:

12. AFFILIATION STATUS: The programme has been affiliated to University of Madras.

13. CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION:

Applicants for M.Tech. (HRD) should submit original B.E. / B.Tech. Degree certificate, Mark Sheets, Transfer Certificate, Community and Conduct Certificate at the time of admission.

The Qualifying Examination passed by the applicant, should be the one, recognized by University of Madras.

At the time of admission, the candidates should pay the amount as prescribed by the Affiliating University towards Recognition, Registration and other charges prescribed by them.

The candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from other Universities shall obtain the eligibility certificate from the University of Madras and submit the same to the Institute at the time of admission to the programme of study.

Candidates are to contact the University Information Centre (Enquiry Office) /ERC Section of the University of Madras to obtain the eligibility certificate
