Information Booklet

Regulations for admission to Post Doctoral Medical Degree courses

2015

1. Jurisdiction of the University

- 1.1. Admission to Post Doctoral Medical Courses in institutions affiliated to “The West Bengal University of Health Sciences” shall be made on the basis of inter-se merit list of candidates appearing in the West Bengal Post Doctoral Medical Admission Test-2015, special (WBPDMAT SPECIAL-2015) to be conducted by the West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS) separately for different disciplines of M.Ch. (Paediatric Surgery, Cardio Thoracic and Vascular Surgery and Plastic reconstructive surgery) courses as detailed in paragraph 2.7 below.

2. Eligibility criteria for M.Ch. courses

- 2.1 Citizens of India who have obtained the requisite Post Graduate Medical degree (MS from colleges affiliated by the Medical Council of India and DNB in broad disciplines (preferably from teaching institute recognized by National Board of Examinations.)
Applicant is eligible to opt for course/courses depending upon MS degree owned by the candidate and disciplines in particular group as detailed in clause 2.7 and arrange preference wise rank.
- 2.2 Application for admission to the Post Doctoral Medical Degree Courses will not be accepted unless the candidates with PG degree have got themselves registered either with a State Medical Council or with the Medical Council of India.
- 2.3 A candidate who has obtained the requisite Post Graduate Medical degree qualification by 30 June 2015 may appear at WBPDMAT Special-2015, but he/she will not be eligible for admission unless he/she produces the proof of passing the said examination from a MCI-recognized institution / DNB recognized institution during admission to be conducted by the University (Date, time and venue of which will be notified in the University Website).
- 2.4. Open Category candidates, if selected have to sign a bond for rendering service for three years after completion of training in Post Doctoral Course as notified by Government of West Bengal vide its memo no. HF/O/MERT/923/ME/MISC-78-13 dated 10.06.2014 failing which such candidate will liable to recompense Government of West Bengal a penal amount of Rs ten lakhs for each defaulting years. Copy of such **notification** is annexed.
- 2.5 In-service candidate working under the Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal is eligible to apply for admission to the 40% of seats reserved for Government sponsored candidates in the State Government run colleges vide order number .HF/O/MERT/433/W-43/13 dated 18.4.2013 issued by Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal.
 - 2.5.1 Such candidates working under Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal are required to consult with relevant Trainee Reserve Rules 2008 and current notification issued by Government of West Bengal from time to time regarding eligibility and other conditions for availing Government sponsored seats before applying for such seats. Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal. issued an order vide memo no HF/O/MA/826/HPT/32M-43-15 wherein it is stated that in-service doctors who obtained PG Degree being placed on Trainee Reserve within 1.4.2012 to 31.3.2015 will not be allowed further TR during 2015. Copy of such **notification** is annexed. Placement on “Trainee Reserve” is the exclusive prerogative and jurisdiction of the State Government in Health and Family Welfare Department.
 - 2.5.2 Once options exercised for the seats reserved for government sponsored seats by a candidate, it is final. In-service candidates cannot declare himself/herself subsequently as “Open” category candidates during the process of selection. If any seat is not filled by the “In-service category”, it will be filled by “Open” category and vice-versa. Similarly, if any candidate opts for “Open” category being in service during filling up form, there is no scope to change the option.
Such candidate is required to be cautious and particular in providing information relating to his/her opting for seats reserved for in-service doctors. Leaving the allotted seat after end of

counselling process which culminates losing of opportunity of other candidate next to him/her in the merit list will attract the provision of penalty.

The decision on getting placed on Trainee Reserve and other service related issues will lie with Government of West Bengal in the Health and Family Welfare Department.

It has been noticed that for in-service candidates being ineligible to apply in in-service category, opt for 'Open category' without obtaining permission from employer, Health and Family Welfare Department. If such situation is detected his/ her candidature will be rejected.

2.5.3 Age of in-service candidates will be guided by T.R. Rules i.e. upper age limit is 50 years as on 31.3.2015.

2.6 Candidate, who has been pursuing any course, including Post Graduate Medical degree courses as mentioned in 2.3 above, is eligible for admission only if he/she completed the course within 30.06.2015. A certificate in this regard from the appropriate authority has to be produced at the time of counseling. Otherwise, he/she has to submit resignation letter duly accepted by the appropriate authority at the time of counseling.

2.7 **Eligibility qualifications:**

3. **Schedule and Method of Submission of application.**

See "Appendix-I" and "Appendix-III" of this document respectively.

4. **Selection process**

4.1 The selection of candidates for admission to M.Ch. Courses will be done on the basis of the marks obtained in the WBPDMAT SPECIAL-2015 (written and interview). Absence in interview will disqualify a place in the merit list.

4.2 Applicants will be provisionally allowed to appear in the WBPDMAT Special-2015. (Written test) provided he/she has submitted online and offline application in the prescribed form strictly following direction in Appendix-I within the last date and has fulfilled the eligibility criteria outlined above.

4.3 The question papers for the Admission Tests shall be set in English

4.4 The question paper (MCQs) for the written test for M. Ch. (3 years) Course shall be of 100 marks for 100 MCQs. Filling up forms for MCh discipline/ disciplines depends upon entry point eligibility of MS/DNB disciplines.

The total time allowed for written test is 80 minutes.

4.5 Total marks for the Written Test will be of 100 marks for 100 MCQs. A candidate will be awarded one (1) mark for every correct answer. More than one response to any question will

be regarded as incorrect answer.

- 4.6 **There is no negative marking for incorrect answer or no answer.**
- 4.7. A provisional eligibility list of the qualified candidates in the alphabetical order to appear for the interview will be published in the University website as per clause 4.8.2
- 4.7.1 Qualifying minimum marks for empanelment for interview will be 50 marks (50%) in the written test.
- 4.7.2 Among the empanelled candidates based on merit list, three times of the available seats in both the category (open and service) will be called for interview. As there is possibility of a candidate getting places in more number of disciplines for more number of options, accordingly additional number of candidate in all such disciplines will be called for interview from the merit list of respective disciplines.
- 4.8.3 The qualified candidates in the written test will have to appear in interview board for respective disciplines of his/her preferences mentioned at the time of filing up forms 100 marks. Slots for interview will be designed without affecting interest of eligible candidates. However, authority of the University will take liberty to constitute interview board with number of disciplines taken together.
No T.A/ D.A is admissible for appearing at the written test and interview. Absence in interview will disqualify a candidate even s/he gets eligible marks in the written test.
- 4.9 Qualifying mark in interview is 50 out of 100.
- 4.10 Qualifying marks for empanelment in the final merit list will be a minimum of 100 marks (50%), written test and interview taken together.
- 4.11 In the event of more than one candidate securing the same marks in the WBPDMAT Special-2015 (written and interview), the rank shall be determined according to the following principles:
- i) The relative position of such candidates in the merit list will be determined on the basis of the marks obtained in the written test of 100 marks; candidate obtaining higher marks in the written test will be placed in the higher rank.
 - ii) If the marks obtained in written test is same, the relative position of candidates securing same marks in the written test in the order of merit will be determined on the basis of the number of incorrect answers, i.e., the candidate with lesser number of incorrect answers will be placed in higher position in merit.
 - iii) If the ranks of the candidates cannot be determined by application of the above principles, the candidate older by age will be in the higher rank than the candidate younger by age.

5. Merit Position of Candidates Qualifying in the WBPDMAT Special-2015:

The individual merit position will be published in every discipline on the basis of total marks obtained in the written test and interview taken together.

Seats will be allotted on the basis of Merit- cum-Choice through Counselling.

- 5.1. The inter-se rank of “ Open” category candidate qualifying in the WBPDMAT SPECIAL-2015 will be determined on the basis of the marks obtained by him/her and option prioritized by him in case choice is more than one. The roll numbers of the qualified candidates will be arranged in the merit list in order of decreasing marks.
- 5.2. There shall be a separate panel indicating the merit positions for the applicants who applied for the seats reserved for the government sponsored candidates.

6. Interview and counseling for selection of candidates for admission

- 6.1. The provisional panel of names of candidates qualified in the written test as well as the date, time and venue of interview will be available at the www.wbuhsexams.in (This website has direct link with main University Website: www.wbuhs.ac.in). No information will be sent to individual candidate in this regard.
- 6.2. Candidates selected for admission through process of counselling must get themselves admitted by the specified date mentioned in the offer letter.
- 6.3. The candidate appearing at interview and subsequent counseling will have to bring the following documents in original along with attested copies of all relevant documents:
- (i) WBPDMAT Special-2015 Admit Card
MS/DNB certificate/ Provisional passing certificate
 - (ii) Registration Certificate issued by MCI/ State Medical Council with inclusion of PG Degree
 - (iii) School leaving certificate as proof of age
 - (iv) Eligibility (Sponsorship) certificate from Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal for getting sponsorship for in-service doctors

- (vi) Course completion certificate from appropriate authority as relevant
- (vii) Identity proof (any one of the following):- Election Photo Identity Card (EPIC) /Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card/ Passport. Candidates without original documents shall not be allowed to appear in the interview.

7. BOND:

- 7.1 Candidate selected for a Post Doctoral seat will be required to sign a bond for completion of tenure of the course, failing which he/she will be required to pay penalty for the default (i.e. non completion of the course) as specified in the relevant Government Order.
- 7.2 All students will execute and submit the bond as mentioned at 7.1 in the office of the respective Head of the Institute immediately after second counselling or before 15.09.2015 (whichever is later).
- 7.3 If a candidate resigns the selection/residency after second counselling, he/she will have to pay the penalty as per 7.1.

8. Process for filling vacant seats

Candidates to be called for counselling depend upon the number of seats and number of candidates eligible for admission.

The process of admission will be completed by 18.09.2015

9. Deposition of fees

Examination fees of Rs.2000/- to be sent along with the hard copy of the application form through draft in favour of The west Bengal University of Health Sciences.

Please do not deposit fee in more than one mode or more than once in one mode.

10. Other important information

- 10.1 Candidate will produce the original and submit photocopy of EPIC/PAN Card /Passport with the application form. Other testimonials are not required with application form.
- 10.2 The allotment of centre will be done by the WBUHS and will be final and binding. The centre once allotted shall not be changed.
- 10.3 There is no provision for rechecking/ re-evaluation of the answer sheets and no query in this regard will be entertained.
- 10.4 Candidates are required to visit the university website regularly for latest information.
- 10.5 Candidate will have to submit scanned signature and photograph in the appropriate place of the online form (Current photograph snapped after publication of booklet) at the time of filling on line application form which are to be used for future tasks like generation of Admit card, attendance sheet , offer letter of admission etc.
- 10.6 Mere getting a place in the merit list will not qualify a candidate if all other relevant conditions are not filled.

APPENDIX-II
GENERAL RULES AND PROCEDURAL DIRECTIVES

1. Applicants should go through and strictly follow the instructions given in the Information Booklet as published in www.wbuhs.ac.in / www.wbuhsexams.in in April 2015 and refer to schedule while applying for different Post Doctoral courses. Application must be complete in all respect.
2. The print-copy of the application along with particular details of payment as applicable as per provision of clause 9 above in favour of **The West Bengal University of Health Sciences** is to be submitted either by hand or by Speed / Registered post to the office of the “**Controller of Examinations, The West Bengal University of Health Sciences, DD-36, Sector-I, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700064**”, so that it reaches the office of the WBUHS as per schedule (Condition applies as stated in Annexure-I)
Candidates are requested to write name, telephone no., mobile no. and “Acknowledgement No.”, mentioned on the print-out of the form on the back of the bank draft. The candidate will mention name of the examination (WBPDMAT SPECIAL-2015) on the back of the envelop.
3. No other document except a photocopy of EPIC/PAN card/ Passport and bank draft is to be submitted with application form.
4. Submission of incorrect or false statements / documents or suppression of material information in the application form will be considered as sufficient ground for cancellation of the candidature or the admission of the candidates to a Post Doctoral medical course whenever detected, i.e. during the process of admission or even at any stage during pursuing the course and thereafter.
5. The selection / admission of a candidate shall stand cancelled if he / she is found guilty of copying from any material whatsoever or of taking the help of any electronic media / devices during the examination, or of assisting others or of being assisted by others in any manner whatsoever in writing out the answers during the examination. In this context, decision of the Centre-in-charge will be final and binding.
6. Candidate can download his/her admit card from the University website on and from 10.09.2015 onwards.
7. The qualified candidates whose names will be published in the Provisional Merit List will have to submit all the attested copies of supporting documents along with originals for verification of their eligibility to the course during interview as mentioned in paragraph 6.3
8. The date, time and venue of interview will be notified in the notice-board of the WBUHS and will also be available in the website <www.wbuhs.ac.in or www.wbuhsexams.in>. No communication in this regard will be made to the candidates personally.
9. Candidates selected for admission after interview must obtain the offer letter on the last day of counseling for the concerned discipline.
10. The candidate, after admission, should report to the head of the institution within 3 working days. Failure to report will render the seat vacant.
11. If a candidate does not report to the allotted institution, his / her admission to the course will be cancelled.
12. No travel allowance is admissible for appearing in the admission, examination or for attending interview.
13. No personal communication will be made to the candidates, unless it is considered absolutely necessary by the University authority.

Guidelines for Submission of application

*1. A candidate seeking admission through WBPDMAT SPECIAL Special is required to submit his/ her application **online** by logging on to www.wbuhsexams.in/www.wbuhs.ac.in Application submitted by all other means will be summarily rejected.

*2. The candidate will, first of all, visit the university website www.wbuhsexams.in through internet. He is required to go through the relevant **'Information Booklet'** carefully and acquaint himself / her with all requirements regarding filling in the application form.

*3. Fill in the **"Online Application Form"** carefully by selecting appropriate options or by typing in appropriate places. Please do not skip any point. Attach your scanned recent passport size photograph, signature in appropriate places. Then click **"submit"** at the bottom of the page to see what you have entered.

*4. Please check the details of your entry in the next page. If you want to change anything, go back to first page and fill again. If necessity arises for change in the First Page , click **"Reset"** at the bottom and continue , then click **"Submit"** at the bottom to go to the next page. After clicking **"Submit"** two more pages will appear with an **"Acknowledgement number "** and the candidate will have to print both the pages as those will have to be submitted to the WBUHS. Please keep photocopies of those pages for your record. Submit the form afresh if you do not get any "Acknowledgement Number." Form without **Acknowledgement Number and missing data will not be entertained.**

Once submitted, no request for change of any entry will be entertained by the University. Print-out of these two pages will have to be submitted to the office of the "Controller of Examinations, West Bengal University of Health Sciences (WBUHS), DD-36, Sector-I, Salt Lake, Kolkata-700064" after:

- i) pasting one current photograph at the appropriate place of the candidate duly snapped after the date of publication of this booklet (must be attested by a gazetted officer or Principal of the college last attended. Photograph will contain name and date)
 - ii) Putting the candidate's signature at appropriate places.
 - iii) The declaration must be signed (which should be full name) in the same page of the declaration.
 - iv) Attaching the bank-draft / pay order for Rs. 2000/- in favour of **"The West Bengal University of Health Sciences"** payable at **Kolkata**
- 4.5. Attaching photocopy of EPIC/PAN Card

**1. The instructions given in the print-outs are to be followed scrupulously. The printed hardcopies of last two pages are to be submitted to the WBUHS either personally or by registered post/ speed post, so as to reach the WBUHS on or before the prescribed last date.

****3. All forms submitted after the stipulated last date/ all incomplete or invalid forms will be rejected without any further reference to the candidate and the fees submitted, if any, will be forfeited as processing charges.**

The OMR answer sheet contains

- (a) Identification information on the left hand side.
- (b) Answer sheet on the right hand side.

(A) Identification information (on the left hand side):

Follow the steps carefully :

Step 1 : Enter the 9 digit Roll Number in the boxes provided against “Roll Number” in the OMR sheet; one digit in each box by blackening the corresponding circles below.

Step 2 : Put your full signature in the box provided.

Step 3 : Use serial nos. 1 to 100 in the right hand side of the OMR Sheet.

Step 4 : Check the “Question Booklet Series” on your Question Booklet It may be any of the alphabets – A/B/C/D/E

Step 5 : Enter the alphabet in the corresponding box against “Question Booklet Series” in the OMR Sheet (on the right hand side)

Step 6 : Blacken the corresponding round containing the same alphabet adjacent to the box. Step 7 : Against each question serial number there are four rounds containing alphabets a/b/c/d.

Answer by blackening the rounds containing the alphabet corresponding to the answer of your choice either of a/b/c/d in the Question Booklet. **Blacken the round completely only by the blue or black ball point pen supplied by the University.**

(Candidates will be provided OMR sheets with a provision for 200 MCQS. But s/he must start from serial no1 and continues up to serial number 100, One cannot start from serial 6 and ends on 105 or from any other serial.)

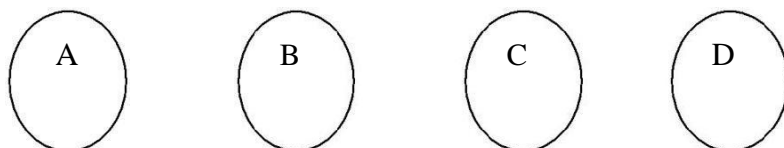

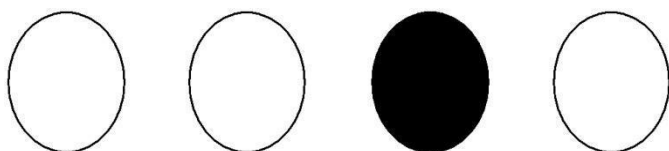

Reservation of 40 per cent of Post-Doctoral, Post Graduate Medical & Dental Degree seats for in-service Medical Officers/ Medical Teachers and 50 per cent of Post Graduate Medical Diploma seats for in-service Medical Officers under this Department within the State quota has remained in place. Vacant seats of any Post Graduate Diploma/Degree seats within the open General quota, if any, are also filled by the in-service candidates, (in case of open general category candidates are unavailable) on the basis of the overall merit position obtained in open general quota through open counseling.

2. Now, the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor is pleased to allow the said reservation till further notification.

Now, in partial modification of Notification Number HF/O/MERT/912/ME/MISC-78-13 dated 31st day of July, 2013, it is hereby ordered that, every postgraduate trainee (other than State Government sponsored in - service doctors) has to execute an indemnity bond to serve this State Government for a period of three years after successful completion of Post Doctoral / MD / MS Course and for a period of two years after successful completion of PG Diploma course, failing which such candidates will be liable to recompense this State Government a penal amount of Rupees Ten lakh for each defaulting year.

All original documents (Mark Sheets, Certificates and documents as required by the Department of Health & Family Welfare, Government of West Bengal from time to time) will be retained by the Department for the purpose of ensuring successful completion of the bond period or payment of penal amount, as may be is applicable. During bond period, specialists will be designated as Senior Resident.

It is also ordered that, this arrangement shall be effective and applicable for the aforesaid Doctors admitted in Post Doctoral / MD / MS & PG Diploma course in State Medical teaching Institutions from the succeeding academic session i.e. 2015-16 and onwards.
