SET Test for Symbiosis Undergraduate Programmes

Symbiosis Entrance Test Overview

The Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET) is a common written test for the admission processes at the undergraduate institutes of Symbiosis International University established as under Section 3 of the UGC Act 1956 vide notification No.F.9.12/2001 U.3 of the Govt. of India. In the year 2002 there were 3 constituent institutes of SIU. Subsequently ten more institutes of Symbiosis have been brought under the ambit of the Symbiosis International University vide notification No.F.9.12/2006-U.3 (A).

This is a mandatory written test for the admission process for the undergraduate programmes at the following Symbiosis institutes:-

1. Symbiosis Law School-[**SLS**] - **Pune**
2. Symbiosis Law School-[**SLS**] – **NOIDA**
3. Symbiosis Institute of Computers Studies and Research-[**SICSR**]
4. Symbiosis Centre for Management Studies-[**SCMS**] – **Pune**
5. Symbiosis Center for Media & Communication-[**SCMC**]
6. Symbiosis School of Economics-[**SSE**]
7. Symbiosis Centre for Management Studies-[**SCMS**]-**NOIDA**
8. Symbiosis Institute of Design-[**SID**]
9. Symbiosis School of Liberal Arts- [**SSLA**]
10. Symbiosis Law School [**SLS**] - **Hyderabad**

The Symbiosis Institute of Technology (SIT) also admits students through JEE Main conducted at the national level.

However, SET is not mandatory for the following:

- 1) Symbiosis institute of Technology (SIT).
- 2) Symbiosis Institute of Health Sciences (SIHS).
- 3) Symbiosis College of Nursing (SCON).
- 4) Symbiosis School of Photography (SSP).
- 5) Symbiosis School for Liberal Arts (SSLA):- **(For International Baccalaureate (IB) students are exempt from SET)**

Note: Candidates who are applying to Symbiosis Institute of Technology (SIT) and Symbiosis Institute of Health Sciences (SIHS), Symbiosis School of Nursing (SCON), Symbiosis School for Liberal Arts (SSLA) [for IB students only] and Symbiosis School of Photography (SSP) should visit their websites for further details.

Candidate should note that SET is only the first step. Each Symbiosis institute has its independent selection process.

- The SET-2016 has 5 different papers:-, General, Design, Law, Engineering and Health Sciences.
- The test will be conducted in two sessions, morning and afternoon.
- A candidate may take more than one paper. However, he will have to choose one paper from the morning session and one paper from the afternoon session.

A candidate aspiring to pursue an undergraduate programme at Symbiosis should carefully follow the actions to be taken in 3 stages mentioned below:

Stage-1: SET Test

- Register online at www.set-test.org
- You may register for one paper in the morning (for example, **Law** or **Design**), and one paper in the afternoon session (for example, **Engineering, General** or **Health Sciences**).

For Engineering and Health Sciences, if a candidate applies for seek admission on the basis of test other than SET, he/she need not register for SET; rather he/she may apply directly to the concerned institute.

- You need to upload your latest scanned photograph at the time of registration.
- Follow the instructions for payment of test fee of **Rs. 1500/-** on the SET Website.
- Print "**admit card**" directly from the SET Website from Monday, April 26, 2016 onwards.
- Bring the admit card and a photo identity proof to the test centre. It will be authenticated during the Test. *(Candidates shall preserve the authenticated admit card till the admission processes of the desired Symbiosis institutes are over.)*
- **If the admit card is lost, no duplicate admit card will be issued.**
- Appear for the test.

Stage-2: Pay online to the desired SIU institutes.

- Candidates can pay to an institute through the SET Website (www.set-test.org).
- Candidates may also pay to the institute through the institute's Website.
- To apply for admission to an institute, a candidate must select for the relevant SET paper. For example, to apply to Symbiosis Law School, pay for Law paper at SET.
- Candidates applying to Symbiosis Institute of Technology (SIT), Symbiosis Institute of Health Sciences (SIHS), Symbiosis College Of Nursing (SCON) with other than SET-2016 score should refer to the respective institute Website and apply.

Stage-3: Attend further selection process of the chosen institutes, if invited.

- Each institute has its own cut-off score, as mentioned in the prospectus.
- The institutes will announce short-listed candidates for the purpose of further selection process.
- The institutes will announce the list of short-listed candidates and the waiting list.
- For learning the details of selection process and schedules, please refer to the Website of respective institute(s).

Important

- Whereas adequate care is taken to ensure that there are no mistakes while reading answer sheets through the scanning machine, there are no provisions or re-evaluation of answer sheets of candidates.
- The scores published by the Symbiosis Test Secretariat shall be final and shall not be subject to any appeal for revaluation.
- The SET score card will be available on the Website for a period of one month from the date of declaration of results, i.e., from Friday, May 20, 2016 to Tuesday, June 21, 2016.
- Those candidates who choose to pay through cash or DD, should ensure the following:
 1. Bank challan for cash payment, (Axis Bank/Indian Bank) or
 2. Demand Draft along with payment advice form for DD payment reaches Symbiosis Test Secretariat by April 26, 2016 at the following address:-

- To complete the registration process, a candidates are required to register online for SET Test at www.set-test.org and appear for the test. It is also mandatory to complete the payment process of the preferred institute for preferred programme before the closing date for payment for the institute.

SET Structure

- Duration:** The duration for SET is 150 minutes.
- The SET is an objective test.
- Papers:** The SET is conducted in two sessions for a total of FIVE question papers.
A candidate may choose to apply for one paper in each session.
- Institutes:** The constituent institutes use scores of the following details for admission.

The SET is an aptitude test and is objective in nature (for all the papers). Each question presents four options as answers. There is no negative marking for wrong answers.
All sections are mandatory.

How to Register For SET – 2016?

Step 1. A candidate can register for one paper from the morning session; viz, **Law** or **Design** and one paper from the afternoon session; viz, **General** or **Engineering** or **Health Sciences** Register at www.set-test.org This will generate your SET ID.

For Engineering and Health Sciences, a candidate need not register for SET if he / she wishes to offer scores of entrance tests other than SET such as JEE(Main). Such candidates may apply directly to the preferred institute.

You must to upload your latest scanned photograph (in the required format and size) at the time of online registration.

Step 2. Pay a non-refundable fee of Rs. 1500/- towards the test fee

Candidates have the option of paying through any one of the following five (5) payment methods:

1. ONLINE PAYMENT THROUGH CREDIT CARD:

➤ You may pay directly through either Master or Visa card online. Follow the instructions given on the SET Website..

2. ONLINE PAYMENT THROUGH NET BANKING:

➤ You may transfer your SET test fee to Symbiosis Test Secretariat account using Net Banking option.

3. ONLINE PAYMENT THROUGH INDIAN BANK NET BANKING:

➤ You may pay your SET test fee to Symbiosis Test Secretariat account. You can also pay the application fee for various institutes through Indian Bank Internet Banking option.

4. CASH:

➤ This 'Payment Advice' form is presented in three parts. Pay **Rs. 1500/-** in cash at Axis Bank or Indian Bank branches in your city. Refer to the list of branches on the Website. The bank will return two parts of the 'payment advice' form to you. The 'student copy' is your receipt.

➤ Sign the Symbiosis copy of the '**Payment Slip**' form stamped by Axis Bank or Indian Bank and send it to:-

The Symbiosis Test Secretariat will authenticate the payment details and will send you an email confirming the payment. Only after the payment is authenticated, would you be able to view your Admit card.

Step 3. Important instructions regarding Admit Card

1. **The SET Test** Admit Card should be printed from the SET Website [www.set-test.org] which will be available from, Tuesday, 26 April 2016 until Saturday, 7 May 2016.
2. Admit Card, along with Photo Identity proof, should be brought to the Test Centre at the time of the test. An acceptable photo identity is any one of the following;
 - Passport
 - Driving license
 - College/ Institute Identity Card
 - Credit card with photograph
 - Voter ID Card
 - Pan Card
 - AADHAR Card (UID)
3. Please ensure that your latest passport-sized coloured photograph is pasted on the Admit Card at the appropriate place before appearing for the test.
4. An authorized person from the Symbiosis International University will verify and authenticate your Admit Card against the photo-id on the test day. Please preserve this authenticated Admit Card for further PI-WAT processes.
5. Candidates should note that an authenticated Admit Card is an important document without which the candidate will not be permitted to appear for further selection processes at SIU. **If the Admit card is lost, a duplicate Admit Card will not be issued.** It should be retained till the admission process is over.

Important

The SET registration fee is non-refundable. Please note that claims for refund of the **SET registration** fee will not be entertained on any account.

At the time of filling the online application form or while appearing for the SET test, any attempt to impersonate or indulge in any other malpractice would automatically disqualify the candidate from admission processes at all under graduate institutes of Symbiosis International University and make the student liable to legal prosecution as per the laws of country.

Every student is urged to note that no donation or capitation fee is required to be paid for admission to any of the Symbiosis institutes. Students are cautioned against falling prey to any such assurance/offer by any individual or outside agency.

1. For the **Morning Session (Law and Design Test)**, reach the test centre latest by 8.45 a.m. The test will start at 9.30 a.m.
2. For the **Afternoon Session (General, Engineering and Health Sciences Test)**, reach the test centre latest by 1:45 p.m. The test procedure will start at 2:30 p.m.
3. Bring the following to the Test Centre:
 - a. The SET 2016 admit card: Candidates will not be allowed to appear for the test without the admit card.
 - b. Photo identity: Bring any one of the following:
 - Passport
 - Driving license
 - College/Institute identity card
 - Credit card with photograph
 - Voters ID card
 - AADHAR Card (UID Card)
 - c. Blue/Black ballpoint pen.
4. Cell phones, calculators, watch calculators, alarm clocks, digital watches with built in calculators/ memory and any other electronic gadgets will not be allowed in the examination hall.
5. Occupy the seat allotted to you by verifying the seat number written on the desk and indicated on your admit card.
6. The Test Invigilator will check your admit card.
7. The test invigilators will instruct you to open the seals of the test booklet 15 minutes before the start of the test.
8. Check immediately to ensure that all the pages of the booklet are in order. In the rare event of the test booklet being defective, bring it to the notice of the invigilator, who will arrange for replacement of test booklet if required.
9. You are not allowed to leave the hall until the test is over and the invigilator collects the Answer Sheets and Test Booklets. You will be allowed to leave the hall only after the Answer Sheets and Test Booklets of all the candidates in your hall have been collected and accounted for.
10. Candidates found using any unfair means will forfeit their chance of being considered for admission and will be debarred from receiving SET scores.
11. Invigilator or Symbiosis Test Secretariat representative will stamp and authenticate your admit card.

*You are required to preserve this authenticated admit card for further selection processes at individual institutes. Duplicate admit card will not be issued in case original is lost by the candidate.

How to pay to Undergraduate Institutes of Symbiosis International University?

You may pay online/offline for admission to an undergraduate institute of the University. The fee is Rs. 1000/- per programme.

There are two options for payment for admission to an institute:

1. **Through the SET Website.**

While paying SET fees online, a candidate may also pay the fee for admission to the preferred institute.

Even after closing of the payment for SET, a candidate may still pay through SET website.

2. **Through the institute Website.**

A candidate may also register separately for SET and pay to an institute. However, SET registration and appearance for the test is mandatory.

It is important to see that a candidate appears for the appropriate SET paper to seek admission.

An institute may offer more than one programme. A candidate should ensure that the preferred programme is selected and paid.

You **cannot** apply to an institute that does not accept the score of the test that you choose to give. For example, if you choose to give the General test only, you cannot apply to SLS. Similarly, if you choose to give the Law test only, you cannot apply to SSE or SCMS or SICSR.

Similarly, you may give the Design test and the Engineering/ Health Sciences test and also apply to SID, SIT, SIHS and SCON.

After declaration of the SET result, the institute to which you have paid will conduct further selection processes for short-listed candidates. The schedule for the same will be published on the Websites of the institutes.

Reservation Policy

As per the UGC guideline 2006, the reservation policy for all the institutes under the University is as follows:

Within the sanctioned intake

SC - 15 %
ST – 7.5 %
Differently Abled – 3 %

Over and above the intake

Kashmir Migrants – 2 seats per programme
International Students – 15 %

Defence Quota – 5 % for SLS-PUNE and SICSR, SCMS-Pune.

Note: Candidate applying for the above mentioned categories will be required to submit the supporting documents at the time of PI-WAT.

Note: The mechanism and the related process for Personal Interaction and Writing Ability Test (PI-WAT) will be updated soon.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Categories listed under International Students Admissions:

Foreign National (FN):

A student is eligible to apply as a Foreign National (FN), if he/she holds a foreign passport.

Person of Indian Origin (PIO):

A student is eligible to apply as a Person of Indian Origin (PIO), if he/she has a PIO card, and is a citizen of a country other than India.

Non Resident Indian (NRI):

A student is eligible to apply as a Non Resident Indian (NRI), if he/she has appeared either for the 10 or 10+2 (equivalent to the Indian 10th & 12th) examination outside India.

It is mandatory for the student who falls in the NRI Category and has appeared for 12th in India to appear for the SET TEST.

Symbiosis Girls Hostel B Wing (Rohan Mithila) with 330 seats capacity has rooms with 'three sharing bases' and Girls Hostel C Wing (Rohan Mithila) with 410 seats has rooms with 'twin sharing basis'. A hostel accommodation is shared with two more institutes on the same campus. Seats are available on "first come first serve" basis only. 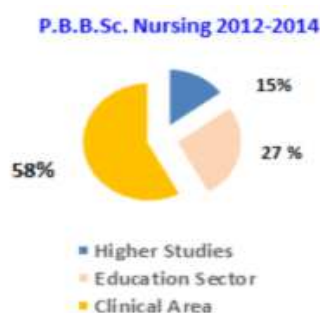
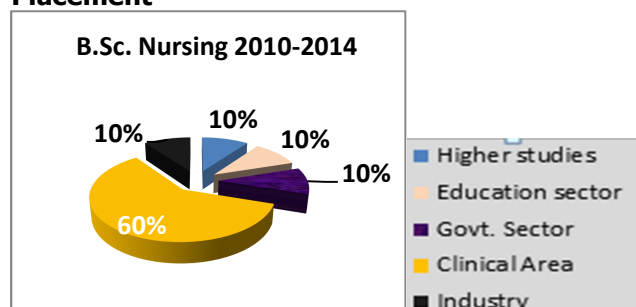

A candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology (PCB) and English each separately and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks taken together in PCB at the qualifying examination i.e., (10+2). Furthermore, in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST or other backward classes, the marks obtained in PCB, taken together in qualifying examination, must be 40% instead of 45% as stated above. English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc. (Nsg.)

a. Placement.

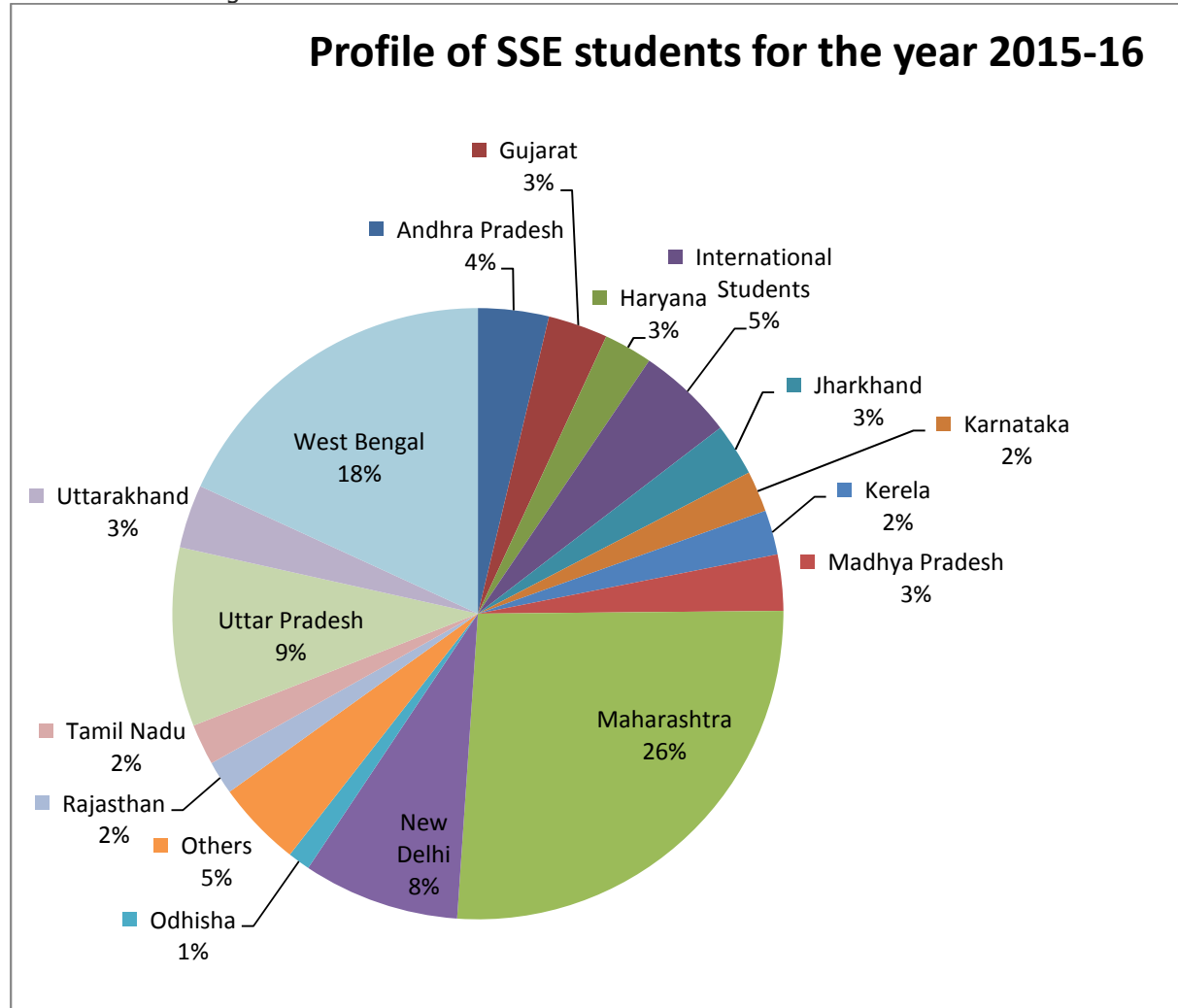

It supports and benefits learners through the privilege of **Text book Gifts:** one for each course in every semester for the life time; **Book Bank:** one text book for each course for the semester; **Home Lending:** two books for 07 days; Reference: any number with in campus on library card; **Study Material:** Study material prepared by course in charge/s.

Additionally, it provides technology based learning resource with access to reading material in various forms such as Legal databases (AIR, SCC Online, Manupatra, WestLaw India, HeinOnline, JSTOR, ProQuest, Kluwer Databases (Kluwer Arbitration, Kluwer Patent, and Kluwer Competition), Ebrary, Case Centre, International Taxation – Taxman, Emerald Management e-Journals and EBSCO), Litigation Documents, Moot Court Memorials, Course Books, Research Papers, National and International Journals.

Moreover, **The Library** is an application provided under **Curiosity** where learners can access class notes, presentations and interesting online videos or articles for further study under each of their subjects. Moot Court Hall

This initiative is well supported by a fully air-conditioned, tech-acoustic, and 220 capacity moot court hall equipped with proper judicial settings. Students' Activity Centre

The SLS-NOIDA believes in strong and positive participation of students in the learning initiatives. It supports and enables students through various cells such as Research & Publication Cell; Moot Court Society, Symbiosis Legal Aid Clinic, Training & Placement Cell, Environmental and Social Welfare Cell, Cultural Cell, Sports Cell, Debate Society, Literary Society, International Law Students Association (ILSA Chapter) and Enactus Chapter. Each cell is provided with its own office spaces fitted with all aids including computer, Internet, printers and support systems at all levels.

The Amphitheatre, under Curiosity, tracks official notices and events at the campus. Students can also reach out to each other for projects, games, trips, exchanges, and other such friendly collaborations using the application.

Girls Hostel

The SLS-NOIDA has the much needed girls' hostel facility, on campus-just behind the academic block in the campus (Limited Seats) and also off campus-nearby vicinity being maintained and managed by Symbiosis Society. The residence complex is a model of comfortable living and learning for our students. It consists of spacious living areas with Wi-Fi facility and an *en-suite* bathroom. Under Graduate:

BA.LL.B and BBA.LL.B (Five Years Integrated Programme)

Methods of Instruction

English is the medium of instruction at SLS-NOIDA. Methods of instruction include interactive Lectures, Seminars, Group Discussions, Simulations, Plays, Case Studies, Moot Courts, Mock Trials, Small Group Workshops and TV-talk shows. In addition, under the 'Extension Lecture Series' banner, inspirational talks of legal luminaries on weekly basis are regular features.

The Flipped Classroom concept is employed regularly where doubts, questions for general debate, and polls are posed on The Banyan Tree, an application under Curiosity. Learners are encouraged to participate by posing questions or providing opinions. The results are then discussed in the classroom in the presence of the teacher who acts as a moderator. The Flipped Classroom initiative ensures that learning transcends the boundaries of the classroom and can happen at any time using the Internet.

Using Curiosity, Learners can also keep close track of their performance in attendance and tests to keep improving. Such information is also available to *Angels*-parents, guardians, siblings, and mentors who have an interest in a child's progress.

The Method of Assessment

The CGPA method of assessment is followed. In addition to the ongoing internal assessments, an external examination is conducted at the end of each semester. Internal evaluation is characterized by one project and a minimum of two options from the following: Tutorial, Case Analysis, Cases and Open problems, Essays, Seminar Presentations, Viva-Voce, Quiz, Drafting, Moot Court, Mock Trial, Learning Logs/Diaries, Computer Based Assessment, Simulated Interviews, and Objective Structured Clinical Examinations. External examination is characterized by objective and subjective questions.

Regular surprise tests (online mode) will also be conducted starting from the academic year 2016-17 using Curiosity, where the students have to complete automated quizzes to test and brush up their theoretical and applied knowledge.

Placement

It is mandatory for every student from the first semester itself to undergo training during the winter and summer vacation, record of such daily work is maintained in the Internship diary provided to each student, which is later submitted to the SLS-NOIDA. Throughout the year, the Training and Placement Cell organizes training programmes to offer to the students the best combination of managerial and leadership skills, to inculcate among them the courtroom or office etiquettes, research experience and advocacy skills. The SLS-NOIDA provides these facilities at all levels to assist the students in their efforts related to Internship and placements in offices of Advocates and Solicitors, Corporate and Cooperative houses, Tribunals & Commissions, Non-Governmental Organizations, National & Multinational Corporations, Media, Telecommunications and Entertainment industries and Judicial clerkship. The Training and Placement cell functions throughout the year and remains in touch with the aforesaid establishments through SIU alumni base. A specialized placement application under Curiosity tracks each learner's career related progression in skills and knowledge and helps the cell be efficient in their operations.

Career Outlook

The SLS-NOIDA students are systematized as per the programme structure from the first semester itself to equip them with the right mix of knowledge and skills, to be ready to handle professional challenges. The SLS-NOIDA is in communication conducts diverse programs of teaching, training and placement inside and outside the campus in partnership with the strong global alumni network of SIU.

Eligibility

BA.LL.B and BBA.LL.B (Five Years Integrated Programme)

Established with a mission to nurture students into sensitive, ethical and critically conscious citizens who will contribute responsibly to their communities and society, the Symbiosis School for Liberal Arts (SSLA) strongly believes in the importance of a more comprehensive education as preparation for career advancement and for the exercise of leadership.

The Symbiosis School for Liberal Arts offers students the opportunity to study a four-year full-time Bachelor of Arts (Liberal Arts Degree) or Bachelor of Science (Liberal Arts Degree) programme spanning eight semesters. The liberal arts programme offers students a wide range of courses across all disciplines with the freedom to pick and choose major and minor areas of specialization from areas conventionally considered to be academically incompatible. A student can therefore combine specialisation areas such as Business with Philosophy, Mathematics & Statistics with Anthropology, English with Media Studies, Biology with Computer Studies and many more. SSLA has the following facilities for its students:

Being part of the same campus as the Symbiosis Law School, SSLA shares all the various facilities that SIU offers.

Library

The SSLA's library is growing rapidly and contains books from various fields, genres and areas of interest. Additionally, students and staff have membership to the nearby British Council Library and the library of the Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics. They also have access to the libraries of all the other institutes of Symbiosis.

Sports and Fitness

Programmes offered:

During the 8 semesters, the students therefore study: 18 core (compulsory) courses + 8 general (electives) + 1 Minor specialization subject (6 papers) + 1 Major specialization subject (10 papers) along with 1 research dissertation + 1 final year seminar paper + 1 comprehensive 2 month internship + 1 comprehensive 2 month community outreach programme.

Placement

SSLA has a career cell that comprises both students as well as faculty members to carry out programmes which will facilitate the easy progress of SSLA students into a career path of their choice (higher education/placement/social sector) after their last year at the college. Students of SSLA have a mandatory internship as part of their four-year programme. The career cell helps students learn to manage their internship, higher education and placement requirements. It also conducts workshops/counselling sessions before students make the important choices of their major/minor areas of specialization

Method of Instruction

Learning methodology includes interactive seminars and group discussions, audio-visuales, lectures and guest speakers / experts, visits and workshops, team learning through projects and assignments, and self-learning through library reference and internships. Our students are evaluated on a continuous basis, which includes essays and term papers, projects, weekly activities / assignments, presentations, class participation and case studies. This is all facilitated due to the small classroom size and interactive pedagogy.

Profile of Past Students

SSLA attracts students from all parts of the country and abroad. The current batches have students from UK, Oman, Nepal, Pune, Mumbai, Bangalore, Delhi, Chandigarh, Kolkata and Lucknow, among other places.

Career prospects

Students with a degree in Liberal Arts will graduate with analytical and communication skills, as well as an ability to synthesize knowledge and make informed decisions. For instance, a student with a Major in English and minor in Business Studies, with a position at a leading newspaper, will walk-in with a larger toolbox of skills, knowledge, and abilities than a regular graduate in English. Additionally, students will be well-prepared for the rigours of academic life at a graduate school of their choosing.

The first batch of students graduated from SSLA in June 2016 and is successfully pursuing their areas of interest today. Some students are studying for their masters at renowned institutes such as John Hopkins, New York Film Academy, etc. Others are working at organisations such as Lintas Lowe, Gateway House, Teach for India, etc.

Eligibility

Students graduating 12th from National / State Board and Non Resident Indians (NRI) students appearing for their 12th examinations in India are eligible.

Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET) is mandatory for all applicants.

Foreign Nationals (FN), Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) & NRIs must apply through the Symbiosis Center for International Education (SCIE).

Diploma holders of International Baccalaureate (IB): IB Diploma Students with predicted scores may also apply: IB students are exempt from SET at the time everyone takes it since their final exams

Admission Process (Additional point added by SSLA into Bulletin)

In keeping with the accepted SSLA admissions process from 2012, SSLA has a slightly differing admissions process for International Baccalaureate (IB) students. The details of the SSLA admissions process for regular and for IB students are as given below:

For all Indian Nationals graduating 12th in India:

Symbiosis Entrance Test (SET)

Recommended Test: SET General. However, candidates who have given Law / Design SET will also be considered if they have not given General SET for any reason. However, these applicants will only be considered if they fall in the top 100 of their respective Law / Design SET rankings.

Cut off for General SET will be decided as per the applications that SSLA receives.

SET = 50 Marks (i.e. 50 % of total – which is as per SIU guidelines)

Personal Interaction & Writing Ability Test (PI-WAT)

Both will be conducted on the same day for a particular student.

PI = 30 Marks, WAT = 20 Marks (Total PI-WAT = 50 Marks)

Merit List

SET (50) + PI (30) + WAT (20) = 100 Marks

For International Baccalaureate (IB) students

All IB students are exempt from appearing for the SET on the nationally (May 7th 2016) declared date in keeping with the policy SSLA has been following since 2012. This is because SET clashes with IB exam dates.

Since they do not appear for SET at this time, all IB applicants will be called for PI-WAT. On this day, prior to the PIWAT, all IB students will appear for a SET like examination equal in composition/difficulty as the regular SET examination. They will pay for the SET registration fees.

Apart from the personal interaction and writing ability test, these students will be required to sit for a test that will make up for their lack of SET score. This test will count for 50 Marks (i.e. 50% of total) and therefore will be in line with SIU UG admissions guidelines.

Personal Interaction & Writing Ability Test (PI-WAT)

Both will be conducted on the same day for a particular student. As written above, the additional test will also be conducted on the same day.

PI = 30 Marks, WAT = 20 Marks (Total PI-WAT = 50 Marks)

Merit List

IB Students Test (50) + PI (30) + WAT (20) = 100 Marks

Merit Lists will be created in a consolidated manner for IB and Non-IB students. There will be no separate merit list only for IB students.

Hostel:

Moot Court Hall:

Moot court is one of the most important simulation activities of student's life cycle. It nurtures their research, analytical, drafting, argumentative skills and helps them to have experiential learning. The SLS, Hyderabad has a grand Moot Court Hall which replicates the real Court Room setup with a seating capacity of 180 to host national and International moot court competitions.

The ICT Learning Resource Center: SLS, Hyderabad has in place an ICT Learning Resource Center for e-research, database access, Lectures, assignments, online exams etc. The ICT lab has 145 seating capacity and it has the following facilities/amenities:

ELIGIBILITY for BA., LL.B & BBA, LL.B

Qualification: The candidate should have passed XII (10+2) examination from any recognized Board with minimum 45% marks (40% for S.C. /S.T. candidates). Students who have appeared for their Standard XII final examination and awaiting results are also eligible to apply, subject to submission of passing certificate at the time of the final admission.

INTAKE

The total intake is 240 seats [Inclusive of 120 seats of BBA, LL.B and 120 seats of BA, LL.B.]

Separate Merit Lists for BBA, LL.B and BA, LL.B programmes will be prepared and published. At the time of SET registration, it shall be mandatory for the candidates to clearly indicate the programme to which they wish to apply (i.e. only one out of the above-mentioned programmes). No request for change of Programme will be entertained at any stage.

Note: It is suggested that those candidates who have studied arts/social sciences subjects for their qualifying examination may apply for BA, LL.B programme. Similarly, those candidates who have studied commerce/accounts/mathematics may apply for BBA, LL.B programme. The candidates are free to make their own choice depending on their ability, interest and opportunity. Please note that these two programmes differ only in First Degree subject (either Humanities OR Business Law) whereas the same Law courses are offered to both the programmes. Graduates in both streams are eligible for diverse legal career and opportunities including Corporate, Lawyering, Civil Services, Advocacy, Judiciary, Academic, International Organization Jobs, and International Admissions etc.
